



YOUTH BOOK: H is for Holy. An Orthodox Christian Alphabet.


Author: Nika Mary Boyd

<u>Please remember, if you have already obtained a civil divorce, you must also receive an Ecclesiastical Divorce from the Church</u>

This brief process is confidentially handled by the parish priest. You must complete this process in order to be in good standing with the Church, meaning that you may not partake in the Sacramental life of the Church, (example: being a sponsor at a wedding or baptism, receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion and Holy Unction, serving on the Parish Council, voting at Parish Assemblies and entering into another marriage).

Please consider your personal situation and be in good standing with the Church. If you have questions or concerns, please contact Fr. Zissis directly.
